## 79. Getting out of the classroom

What you need: for Question Trails, hidden question cards, answer sheets, pens, clipboards Subject links: any

- QUESTION TRAILS
   Hide a number of questions around a location (hall, playground, classroom, etc). Pupils must locate the numbered questions and answer them in the correct place on the sheet within a given time limit. Differentiate by providing different colours, fonts and symbols of questions for different groups. Each group must answer its own set of questions within a time limit.
- Increase the amount of pupil interest by taping question cards to the underside of furniture, inside cupboards, sideways along pillars, etc.
- STOP THE CLASS, I WANT TO GET OUT! If the classroom is stuffy and hot, or if the class is restless, stop fighting their fidgets and get the class outside for a five minute walk around the school building at a brisk pace. Leave the windows wide open while you are out, even if it's a cold day; it will soon warm up upon 30 bodies' return.
