

124. Mistakes

What you need: passage with prepared 'errors'

Subject links: any

- ◆ Slowly read out a passage which contains deliberate mistakes. As they listen, pupils should note the errors and write down the correct facts instead. Pupils could then indicate the correct answers either by voting with a show of hands for the correct answer, or by using their personal whiteboards to all display the correct answers together.
- ◆ The incorrect passage may also be written on a whiteboard or differentiated sheets. Pupils should investigate and discuss in teams what is incorrect and work together to use resources to make the necessary corrections. A time limit can be set.

- ◆ Write a text about a given topic in EXACTLY 200 words or in EXACTLY 10 minutes.
- ◆ Alternatively, write down a clear definition in exactly 20 words. All words produced MUST make sense and be grammatically accurate.
