Paying attention/concentration/memory

- ◆ Sit the children down in a circle.
- ◆ Explain that one player starts by saying: 'A boat has just sailed from overseas full of ... ', and he/she gives the name of an animal etc.
- ◆ One by one, everyone in the circle must repeat the sentence, saying the word(s) that have been said already (in this case an animal) and add their own.
- ◆ Children must not spend a lot of time thinking about it.

Variations: The game can also be played using words that begin with a specific letter. Alternatively players could be forbidden from repeating a word that has already been used.
