

42. Reach for the sky

- ◆ Knowing your right hand from your left hand can often be confusing so this is a fun way for them to remember.
- ◆ The players form a large circle.
- ◆ The teacher chooses one child to walk around the inside of the circle and when the child stops they say to whichever child is in front of them: 'Reach for the sky'.
- ◆ At this point the person standing in front must remain as they are, whilst the person to their right must raise their right hand and similarly the person to their left must raise their left hand.
- ◆ Sounds easy enough but after a while it can become challenging because whoever gets it wrong then replaces the lead role.
