Vocabulary:	Food items (<i>une banane, une pomme, des biscuits, un bonbon</i>)
Functions:	Polite requests (<i>je voudrais ... s'il te plaît</i>); thanking (<i>merci</i>)
Grammar	Modal verb <i>vouloir</i> : <i>Je veux/je voudrais</i>
Characters	5 (3 children, 1 mum, 1 dad)
Props:	Fruit bowl; fruit (with apple and banana); plate; biscuits; bag of sweets
Costumes:	eg scarf (mum), cap (dad)
Sound effects:	None
Set:	A kitchen, with table and chairs
Chorus possible:	No

Notes

- Encourage pupils to use polite forms of address with you and with each other when speaking French.
- Remind pupils to use facial expression and body language to reinforce what is being said.

Translation

I want a sweet!

Scene 1

Child 1	Mum, I want a banana!
Mum	No! You must say: 'I'd like a banana, please!'
Child 1	I'd like a banana, please.
Mum	Here is a banana. You must say: 'Thank you!' Dear, oh dear, children!

Scene 2

Child 2	Dad, I want an apple!
Dad	No! You must say: 'I'd like an apple, please!'
Child 2	I'd like an apple, please.
Dad	Here is an apple. You must say: 'Thank you.' Dear oh dear, children!

Scene 3

Child 3	Mum, I want some biscuits!
Mum	No! You must say: 'I'd like some biscuits, please!'
Child 3	I'd like some biscuits, please.

Dad	Here are some biscuits.
Mum + Dad	You must say: 'Thank you.' Dear oh dear, children!

Scene 4

Dad	Mmmm! I want a sweet!
Mum	Mmmm! I want a sweet!
Child 1	No! You must say: 'I'd like a sweet, please!'
Dad	I'd like a sweet, please.
Mum	I'd like a sweet, please.
Child 2	Here is a sweet.
Child 3	Here is a sweet.
Children	You must say: 'Thank you!' Dear, oh dear, parents!
