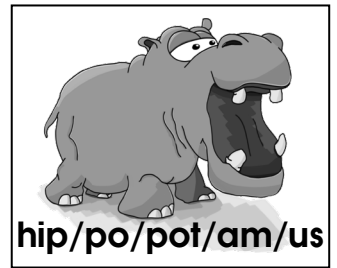

Spelling Strategies

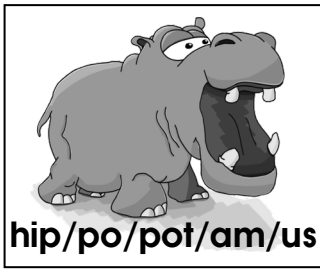
