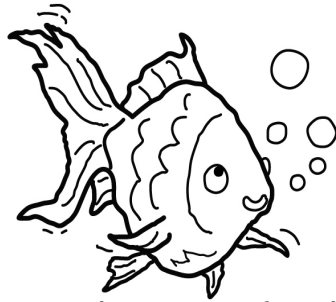


Simple sentences

Simple sentences are made up of one clause. They have a verb and they make sense on their own. The verb (doing word) has a subject, which is the person or thing doing the action. Like this:

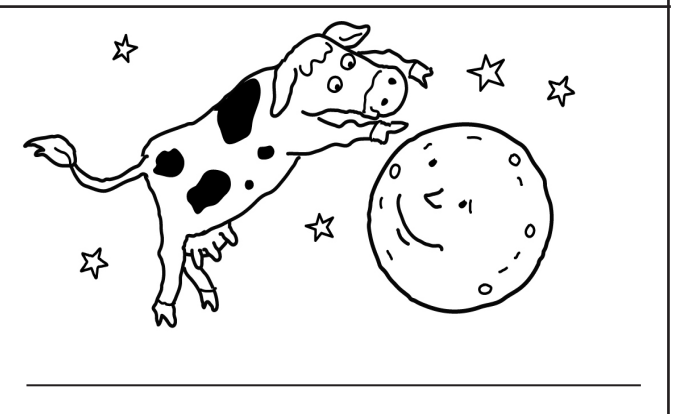
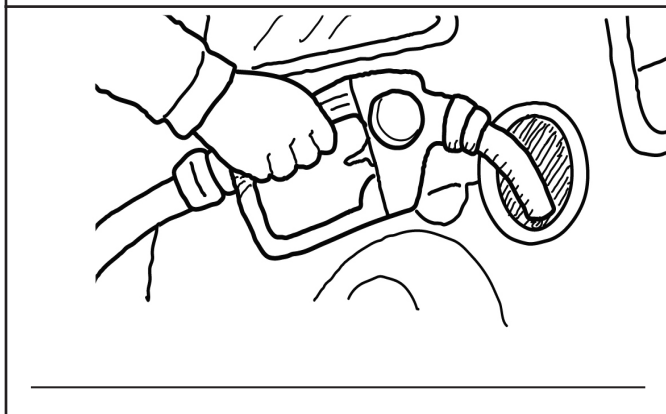
subject verb
A fish swims.



subject verb
The dog ate my book.

subject verb
The train stopped at the station.

Write simple sentences for these pictures:
