## Articles



An **article** is the word we put before a noun. There are only three articles in the English language:



The man is next door.

<u>A</u> and <u>an</u> are called **indefinite** articles because they refer to one of a group of things. <u>A</u> is used in front of words beginning with a consonant while <u>an</u> is used in front of words beginning with a vowel. Fill in the blanks.
