Proper nouns can name:

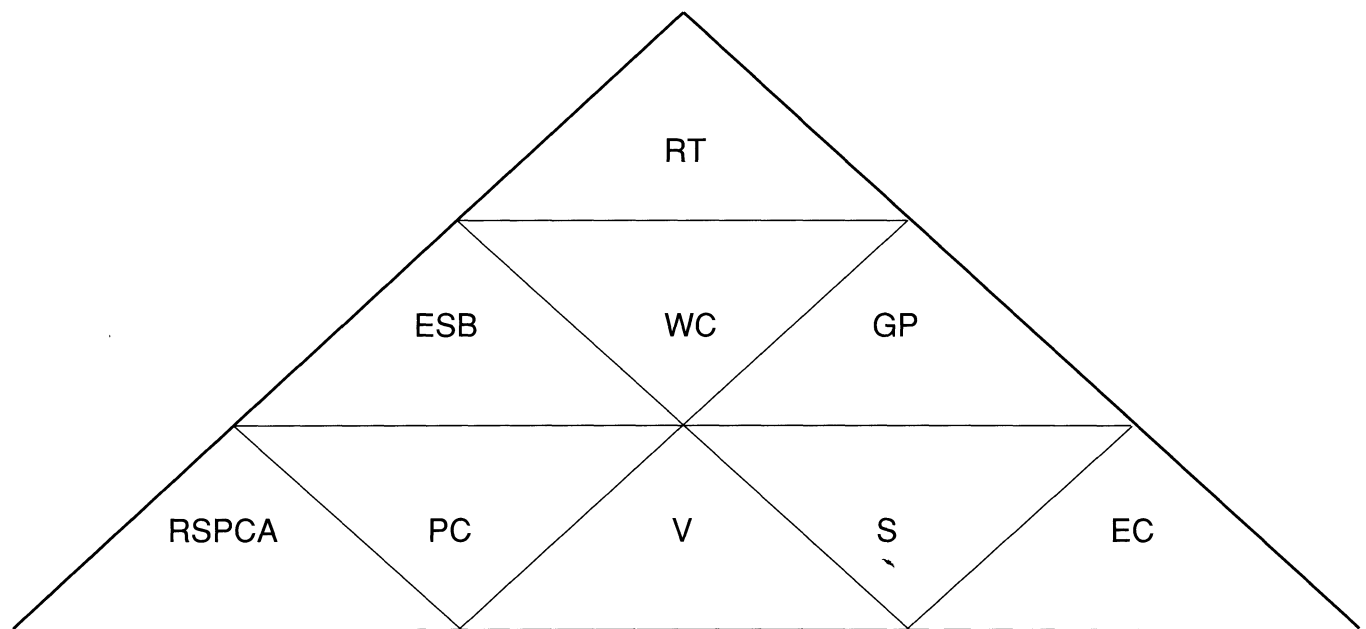
people: Mr Rogers, Lucy, Mike Jones, Manjit Gill

places: New York City, London, Cornwall, Asia, Mars

things (like TV programmes, films or brand names):

Neighbours, Brookside, Blockbusters, Snickers
