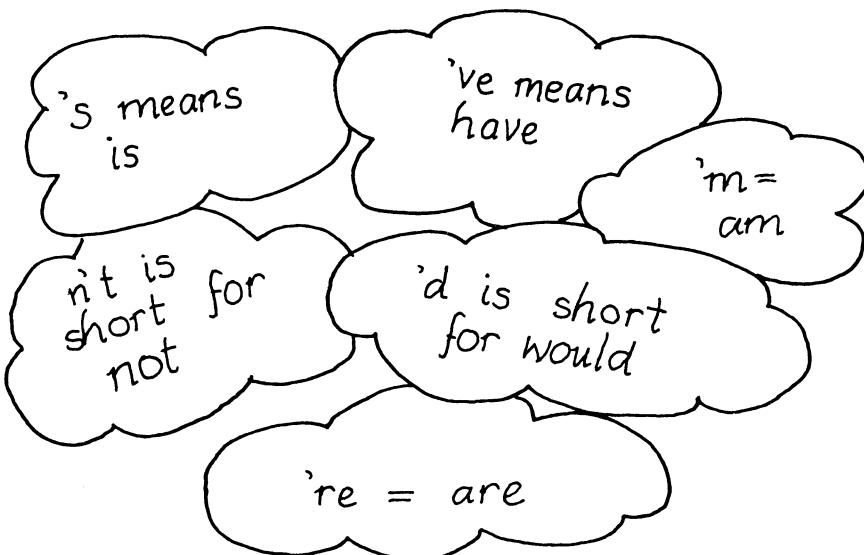


# Contractions
