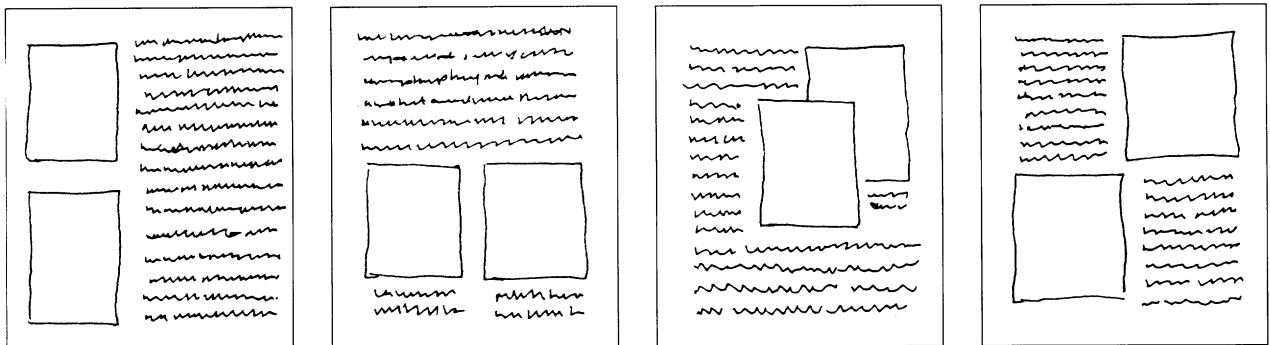


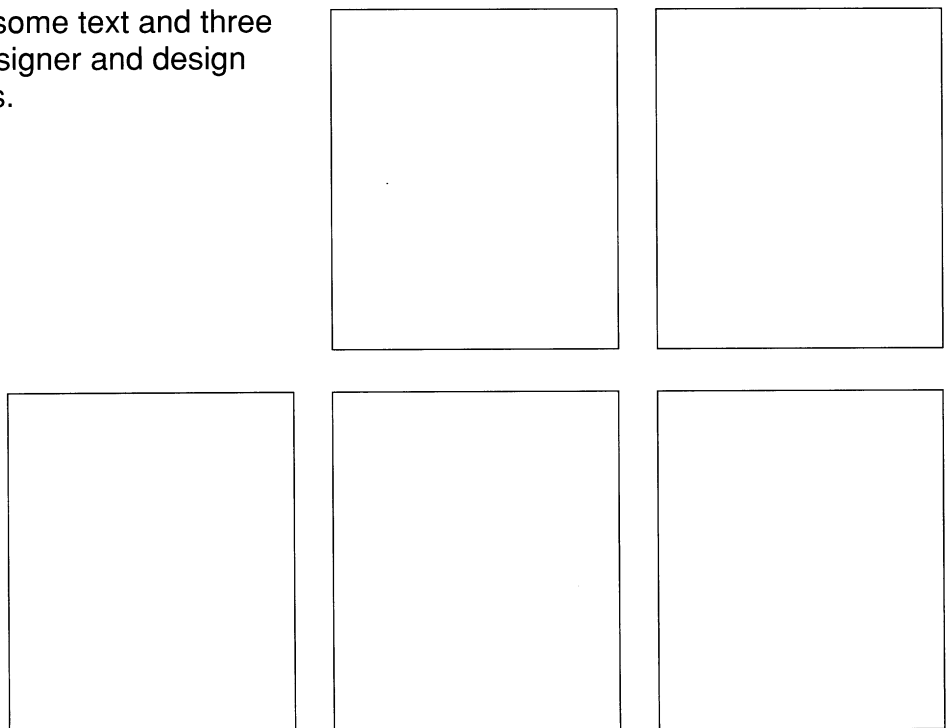
Be a graphic designer

Graphic designers are the people who design books. They plan how each page will look before they begin to put a book together. These plans are called 'page layouts' and they should tell you exactly where everything will go.

The way you design your page makes a lot of difference to how the finished book will look. For example, suppose you have lots of text and two pictures. Discuss with a friend which of these four page layouts you prefer. Why?
