

Add and subtract 3-digit numbers (4)

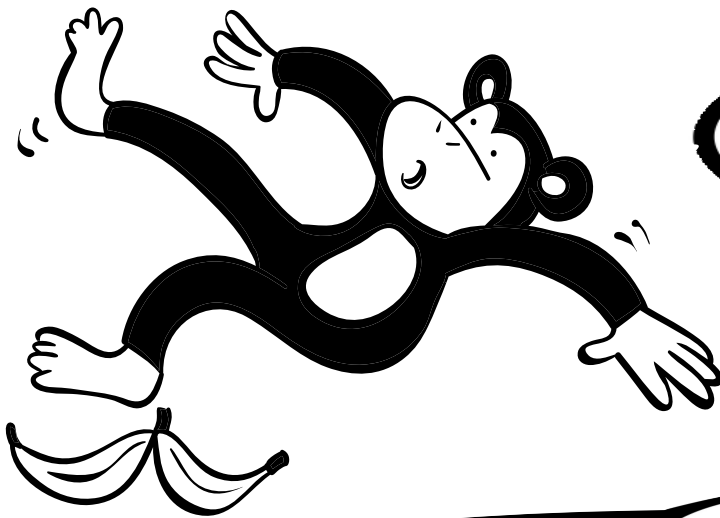
Learning objectives
