
Long Jump Jim's 10 times table activities



$$1 \times 10 = 10$$

$$2 \times 10 = 20$$

$$3 \times 10 = 30$$

$$4 \times 10 = 40$$

$$5 \times 10 = 50$$

$$6 \times 10 = 60$$

$$7 \times 10 = 70$$

$$8 \times 10 = 80$$

$$9 \times 10 = 90$$

$$10 \times 10 = 100$$

$$11 \times 10 = 110$$

$$12 \times 10 = 120$$

Jump as far as you can down the garden, counting in 10s as you go!

Challenge your parent to a long jump challenge. Every time you jump the furthest, up your score by 10!

Throw a bean bag, then jump to it counting in 10s. Try again, seeing if you can throw further this time!
