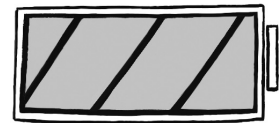


SCROOGE

IMPORTANCE:

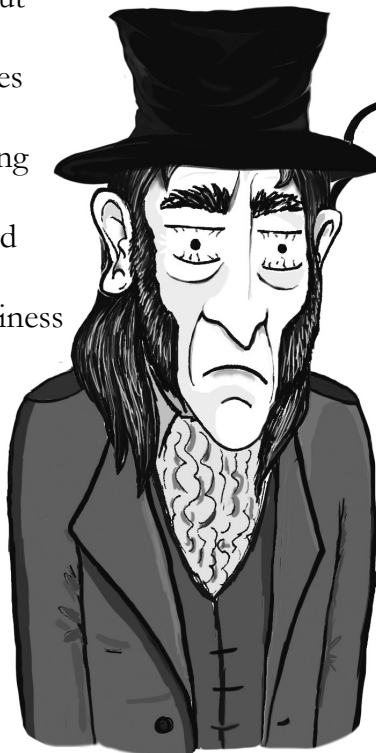
