Making Potions

We use the words 'and' and 'because' to join words to make sentences flow more smoothly. These words are called **conjunctions**.

Can you help Wizard Wong join his sentences to make his potions using 'and' or 'because'?
1. Put in one spider web three dandelions.
2. Then crush together with three toenails four warts in one bowl.
3. Do not squeeze the flowers it will ruin the spell.
4. Use a big cauldron it is a big mixture.
5. Mix the raindrops dew gently together.
6. Take care with the cauldron it will be hot.
Wizard Wong has given his apprentice careful instructions about some spells. Sadly he has forgotten his conjunctions. Can you help him? Use 'and' or 'because'.
1. Do not drop the bottles they will break.
2. Put the spiders' websdewdrops together in one bottle.
3. Leave the wart potion it is dangerous.
4. Take the broomsticks wands into the shed wash
them.
5. The wattle flowers daisy leaves should go in the blue bowl
they have to be soaked.
6. The buttercup potion love potion must go in a dark room
they need to rest for three hours.
7. Do not put the dragon scales near the fire they might explode!
