

On the Set

The **subject** of a sentence does the action to the **object**. For example: Benny ate the bananas. Benny is the **subject**. He is doing the eating. The bananas are the **object**, they are being eaten!

Can you make up some catastrophes of your own for the following subjects?

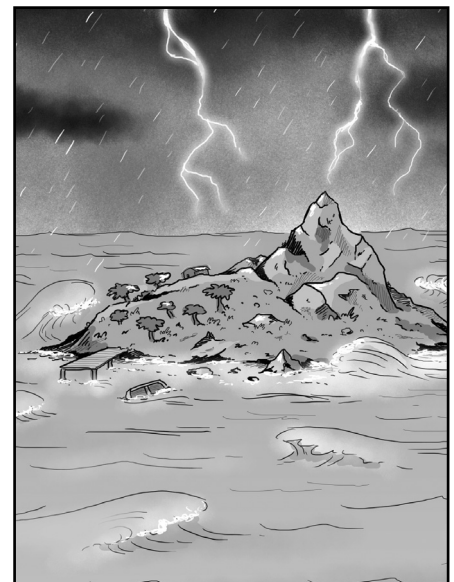
Gerda Grenville,
